Sub: Extension of provisional temporary approval of affiliation to KMCT Law College, Kuttippuram, Malappuram, Kerala for three year LL.B as well as five year BBA LL.B and five year B.Com LL.B law courses for the academic year 2022-2023 with the prevalent/existing sections (earlier specifically approved in writing by BCI) with intake of not more than 60 students in one section

Sir,

This is with reference to above mentioned subject regarding extension of provisional approval of affiliation to **KMCT Law College, Kuttippuram, Malappuram, Kerala** which has already applied for extension of approval of affiliation for the academic year 2022-2023.

This is to bring to your kind knowledge that the following resolution was passed on 08th June, 2022 by the General Council of the Bar Council of India with respect to grant of provisional approval of affiliation for academic year 2022-2023 for those centers of Legal Education which have applied for approval of affiliation for the academic year 2022-2023.

“RESOLVED that with respect to existing Centers of Legal Education/colleges, whose inspection fee has been deposited, application for extension of approval of affiliation is pending, no inspection could be done or the inspection has been done, but inspection report could not be placed before the Legal Education Committee or the Standing Committee for its consideration, such Centers of

Legal Education/colleges may continue to admit students only for the academic year 2022-2023.

This will apply only in case where affiliation has been granted by the University.

Such provisional approval shall be subject to any decision taken after the inspection of the CLE is done by the Bar Council of India subsequently.

It shall further be conditional and is subject to compliance as per circular dated 05.02.2020 bearing No.BCI:D:158 (LE:Circulation No.01/2020), issued to all Centers of Legal education, as per the extended time of such compliance, whereby every center of Legal Education/college is required to submit a certified authenticated bank statement bearing bank stamp, date and signature, mandatorily with respect to the salary/ies being disbursed to all the teachers/faculties every three months with effect from March, 2022 on a regular basis, unless specifically sought at other intervals, and also furnish list of teachers with qualifications as per BCI and UGC Rules, and further furnish proof/receipts of fulfillment of minimum library requirements, as enumerated under Schedule-III, Rule-15, Minimum Library requirements of Legal Education Rules-which is the sine qua non of a Center of Legal Education. Certain show cause notices and compliance letters had also been issued specifically to certain Centers of Legal Education/Colleges, with conditions mentioned therein, which have to be complied too as per the time stipulations therein, and if they have not been complied with they must be complied with immediately.

An affidavit/undertaking to comply with the conditions mentioned in the above referred circular and of all the rules of Legal Education, shall be required to be submitted by way of duly notarized affidavit within 15 days of receipt of this letter by way of hardcopy and also by way of scanned copy at complianceaffiliationle2@gmail.com with heading-COMPLIANCE TO PROVISIONAL APPROVAL-REQUIREMENTS

It is made clear that if any Center of Legal Education, fails to submit all the required documents as sought by way of the afore referred circular and the show cause notices (where applicable), and the compliance letters, already issued, then their application for extension of approval for 2022-2023 shall not be considered and, if, approval is granted for the academic session 2022-2023, it may be withdrawn.

You may kindly bear in mind that the Bar Council of India is the sole and supreme sanctioning authority for seats and as a general rule it does not allow any supernumerary quota of seats for law degree courses, over and above the sanctioned strength of seats and whatever reservation of seats is to be done by the University as a general rule has to be done within sanctioned strength of seats.

The Center/s of Legal Education/College may take a note of the above mentioned facts and furnish compliance of the same and of the other rules and regulations of Legal Education, including the stipulations specified in the above said referred circular/s, show cause notices and compliance letters, and in ANNEXURE-A, attached to this provisional approval of affiliation letter, which is required to be complied with adequate documentary proof and by way of a

notarized affidavit, immediately if the same has not already been complied with, failing which, their application for extension of approval for 2022-23 shall not be considered and if approval, is granted for the academic session 2022-2023, the same may be withdrawn too.”

The last date for compliance of the above referred circular has expired on 31st August 2022, as it was extended from time to time due to the pandemic.


Therefore ensure to comply with the same, otherwise the provisional approval of affiliation being issued herewith may be withdrawn.

Since the affiliating University has provided affiliation for the academic year 2022- 2023 to **KMCT Law College, Kuttippuram, Malappuram, Kerala** the affiliating University is hereby intimated that the above referred CLE has been approved by Bar Council of India to admit students in **three year LL.B as well as five year BBA LL.B and five year B.Com LL.B law courses** for the academic year 2022-2023 with the prevalent/ existing (earlier approved by BCI) sections, for the academic year 2022-2023.

The compliances and pending fee/ any other fee which may be payable in future may be kindly ensured to be complied with as and when intimated in the future.



ORDER

Provisional affiliation was granted to start the K.M.C.T. Law College (Unaided), Pazhur P.O., Kuttippuram, Malappuram with programmes of 5 year B.B.A-L.L.B with an intake of 50 students and 3 year LLB programme with an intake of 50 students during the academic year 2013-14 vide the U.Os read as 1st.

2. An additional batch of 50 students for the 5 Year B.B.A. L.L.B. programme at K.M.C.T. Law College (Unaided), Kuttippuram, Malappuram from the academic year 2016-17 was sanctioned vide U.O. read 2nd.

3. Permanent increase of 10 seats was granted to 5 year BBA-LLB programme at the college for the academic year 2018-19, vide U.O read as 3rd above.

4. Additional affiliation to 5 year B Com-LLB (Hons) programme with an intake of 120 seats (60x2 batches) has been granted to the college for the academic year 2020-21 vide U.O read as 5th above.

5. The Bar Council of India ,vide paper read as 6th above, granted extension of provisional temporary approval for 5-Year B.B.A-L.L.B , 5-year B.Com-L.L.B (Hons) and 3-year L.L.B programmes for the academic year 2021-22 .

6. CPA was granted to 3 year L.L.B with an intake of 50 , 5 year B.B.A L.L.B with an intake of 110 (2 batch) & 5 year B.Com L.L.B (Hons)with an intake of 120 (2 batch) programmes for the academic year 2021-22 vide U.O read as 8th above,on conditional basis subject to the submission of renewal NOC from Govt.of kerala & BCI approval for the year 2021-22.

7. Vide G.O read as 9th, the Dept. of Higher Education , Govt.of Kerala has renewed the NOC for conducting self financing programmes 5 Year B.B.A-L.L.B programme ,3 Year L.L.B degree programme and 5 year B.Com-L.L.B programme at K.M.C.T. Law college, Mampara, Pazhur PO, Kuttippuram, Malappuram for the academic year 2021-22

8. The Principal, K.M.C.T. Law College (Unaided), Pazhur P.O,Kuttippuram,Malappuram, vide paper read as 10th, has requested to grant Continuation of provisional Affiliation to 5 Year B.B.A-L.L.B programme with an intake of 110 students (two batches) , 3 year L.L.B programme with an intake of 50 students and 5 year BCom L.L.B (Hons) programme with an intake of 120 students (two batches) for the academic year 2022-23 so as to obtain the approval for the college from Bar Council of India, since the Continuation of Provisional Affiliation order from the University is necessary for obtaining approval to L.L.B programmes in the college for the ensuing years. The college has remitted an amount of ₹1,37,815/-(Rupees One Lakh Thirty Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen only) towards administration and affiliation fee vide chalan No.212593587 dated 20.12.2021.

9. The Principal has submitted necessary documents along with the application which have been insisted in the U.O. and Circular read as 4th & 7th

10. Considering the above, the Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to 5-Year B.B.A- L.L.B programme (110 seats), 3-Year L.L.B. programme(50 seats) and 5 year BCom L.L.B (Hons) (120 seats) in K.M.C.T. Law College (Unaided), Pazhur P.O,Kuttippuram, Malappuram,for the academic year 2022- 23 on conditional basis subject to the submission of approval order from Bar Council of India for the year 2022- 23 and renewal NOC from Government of Kerala , for the academic year 2022-23 with strict directions to Principal of the College vide Circular read as 11th, to engage faculties with qualifications prescribed by the UGC and in compliance to the provisions of the ACT 13 of 2021 Kerala Self Financing teaching and non teaching employees(Appointment and conditions of service) .

11. Continuation of provisional affiliation is, therefore, granted for the following programmes and intake as detailed below in K.M.C.T. Law College (Unaided), Pazhur P.O,Kuttippuram, Malappuram,for the academic year 2022-23 on conditional basis subject to the submission of approval order from Bar Council of India for the year 2022-23 and renewal NOC from Government of Kerala , for the academic year 2022-23 with strict directions to the Principal of the Colleges to engage faculties with qualifications prescribed by the UGC and in compliance to the provisions of the ACT 13 of 2021 Kerala Self Financing teaching and non teaching employees(Appointment and conditions of service).

12. Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2022-23. The College has to apply for the continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years, remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of the letter of extension of approval from the Bar Council of India.The Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years should be obtained after

applying for the same along with the required fee and extension of approval order from the apex body concerned.

13. Selection and admission shall be made only on the basis of the Rules and Regulations of the University/Government and on the directions issued by the University/ Government from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will automatically be cancelled. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University and the Bar Council of India.

14. The conduct of University Examinations of any sort, including that of S.D.E Examinations, is compulsory and binding on all Colleges affiliated to the University of Calicut

15. The Controller of Examinations shall ensure that examinations are not conducted in those colleges which do not have valid affiliation orders.

16. In the light of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP(C) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for the prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including the withdrawal of affiliation of the college will be initiated.

Orders are issued accordingly.
